Freeport-McMoRan's Bagdad mine generated an estimated \$119.0 million in economic benefits for Yavapai County and approximately \$276.1 million for Arizona in 2015. Our Company contributes in many ways to the sustainability of the various communities, counties and states in which we operate. They rely heavily on the economic benefits directly and indirectly provided by our various operations in the form of wages and taxes we pay as well as the goods and services we purchase. This direct spending ripples through the economy, inducing additional economic benefits and contributing to more jobs and greater tax revenues.

The charts to the left explain how our Bagdad mine provides such a boost to the county and state economies.

Freeport-McMoRan's Bagdad mine had 810 employees at the end of 2015 and a total impact of approximately 2,580 jobs on Arizona's economy.
