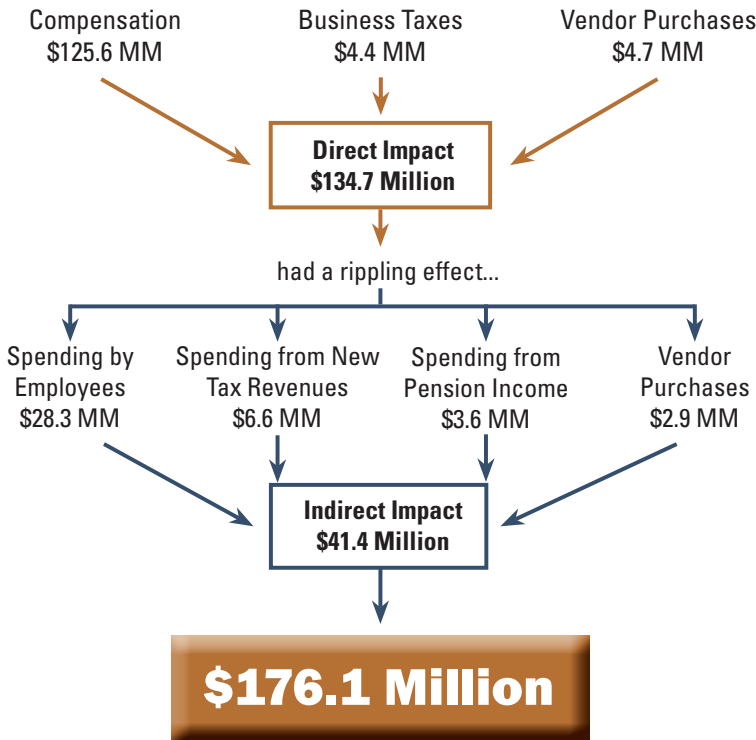


# IMPACT OF FREEPORT-McMoRAN ON THE ECONOMY OF GRANT COUNTY AND NEW MEXICO – 2015

## Freeport-McMoRan's Impact on Grant County



Freeport-McMoRan's New Mexico operations, primarily the Tyrone mine and the Chino mine, generated an estimated **\$176.1 million** in economic benefits for Grant County and approximately **\$422.4 million** for New Mexico in 2015.

Freeport-McMoRan contributes in many ways to the sustainability of the various communities, counties and states in which we operate. They rely heavily on the economic benefits directly and indirectly provided by our various operations in the form of wages and taxes we pay as well as the goods and services we purchase. This direct spending ripples through the economy, inducing additional economic benefits and contributing to more jobs and greater tax revenues.

The charts to the left explain how our New Mexico operations provide such a boost to the county and state economies.

**Freeport-McMoRan had nearly 1,450 employees in New Mexico at the end of 2015 and a total impact of more than 4,430 jobs on the state's economy.**
