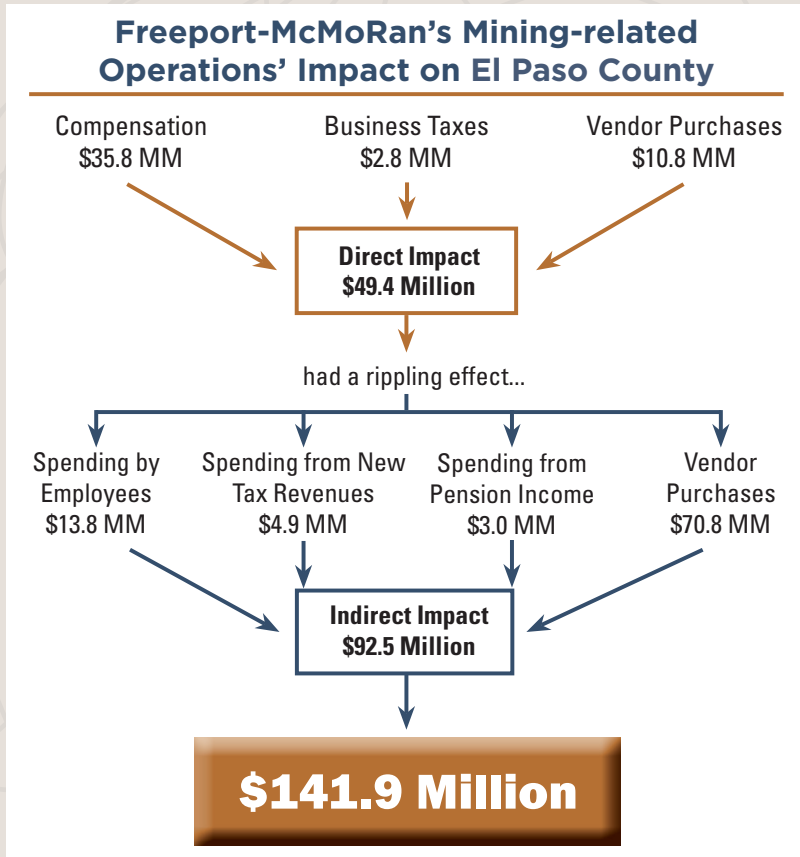


IMPACT OF FREEPORT-McMoRAN ON THE ECONOMY OF EL PASO COUNTY AND TEXAS FROM MINING-RELATED OPERATIONS – 2015

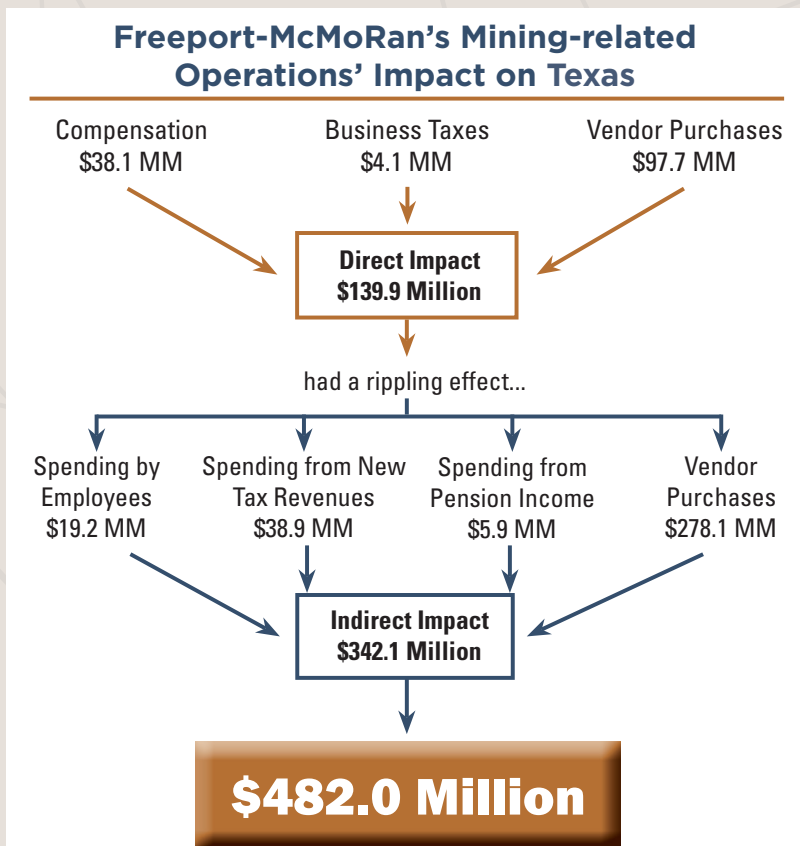


Freeport-McMoRan generated an estimated **\$141.9 million** in economic benefits for El Paso County and approximately **\$482.0 million** for Texas in 2015.

Freeport-McMoRan contributes in many ways to the sustainability of the various communities, counties and states in which we operate. They rely heavily on the economic benefits directly and indirectly provided by our various operations in the form of wages and taxes we pay as well as the goods and services we purchase. This direct spending ripples through the economy, inducing additional economic benefits and contributing to more jobs and greater tax revenues.

The charts to the left explain how Freeport-McMoRan provides such a boost to the county and state economies.

Freeport-McMoRan employed nearly 370 workers in Texas at the end of 2015 and had a total impact of more than 3,770 jobs on the state's economy.
