The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") has reviewed the First Quarter 2012 Groundwater Monitoring Report, Tasks 1.0 and 2.2 of ACR Mitigation Order on Consent P-121-07. Results showed no major changes in sulfate concentrations at the wells sampled during the first quarter of 2012 and ADEQ has no additional comments after its review.

ADEQ has reviewed the sixteenth Mitigation Order on Consent No. P-121-07 March 1, 2012 through May 31, 2012 Status Report submitted by Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold – Copper Queen Branch. The status report documented measures that have taken place between March and May 2012 and measures that will be conducted during the next quarter of 2012. ADEQ does not have any comments on the 2nd quarter of 2012 status report.

The Feasibility Study and Mitigation Plan for Drinking Water Supplies Affected by Sulfate dated March 28, 2012 is currently under review by ADEQ. Comments on the mitigation actions and measures discussed in the submittal are forthcoming.
