Phelps Dodge Sierrita, Inc. – Mitigation Order on Consent, Docket No. P-50-06

Dear Mr. Casey:

Phelps Dodge Sierrita, Inc., operating as Freeport-McMoRan Copper and Gold, Sierrita Operations ("Sierrita"), has conducted five rounds of quarterly groundwater monitoring under the Mitigation Order starting in the fourth quarter of 2006. In accordance with our October 31, 2006 Work Plan to Characterize and Mitigated Sulfate with Respect to Drinking Water Supplies in the Vicinity of the Phelps Dodge Sierrita Tailing Impoundment, groundwater samples have been analyzed for both dissolved and total sulfate. As was stated in our December 19, 2007 Fourth Quarter 2007 Groundwater Monitoring Report, the difference between dissolved and total sulfate concentrations has been negligible. As a result, we propose that future analyses of groundwater samples be limited to dissolved sulfate as was recommended in our September 26, 2007 Third Quarter 2007 Groundwater Monitoring Report. If possible, we request that ADEQ provide written approval of our proposal by February 8, 2008 so that we can implement this change during the first quarter of 2008 groundwater monitoring.
