# 2021 U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Reports (EEO-1) Disclosure Supplement

Freeport-McMoRan Inc. (Freeport) is a leading international mining company with headquarters in Phoenix, Arizona. We operate large, long-lived, geographically diverse assets with significant proven and probable reserves of copper, gold and molybdenum. Our portfolio of assets includes the Grasberg minerals district in Indonesia, one of the world's largest copper and gold deposits and significant mining operations in North and South America, including the large-scale Morenci minerals district in Arizona and the Cerro Verde operation in Peru.

We are committed to publicly disclosing the information in our consolidated EEO-1 report, which characterizes our U.S. employees by race, ethnicity and gender across job categories established by the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. This document supplements our 2021 Annual Report on Sustainability and 2021 ESG Data disclosures.

## Our Approach to Inclusion & Diversity

As a global organization that operates in diverse parts of the world, Freeport recognizes the importance of inclusion and diversity as a company priority. We believe an inclusive and diverse workforce with a broad range of experience, knowledge, background, culture and heritage drives innovation, enhances operational performance and improves relationships with stakeholders.

We operate in regions of varying ethnic, religious and cultural backgrounds, where we often are the largest employer in our host communities. We are committed to fostering a company culture that is not only safety-focused, respectful, and inclusive, but that is also representative of the communities where we operate. Ninety-nine percent of our employees are from the countries where we operate. It is from this context that we seek to tailor our approach to inclusion and diversity — by all definitions — across our global business.

In recent years we have advanced efforts to enhance our tracking and public disclosure of various diversity metrics and data points across our global workforce, as reflected in our 2021 Annual Report on Sustainability and 2021 ESG Data disclosures. We continue to consider ways to collect and gather the most meaningful data for each of our global operations.

As part of this effort, we began voluntarily disclosing a consolidated summary of our 2021 EEO-1 data. We note the EEO-1 is only one component of data as it is limited to representational reporting in U.S. federally mandated job categories that differ across our global operations. At the end of 2021, our global workforce totaled approximately 24,700 employees and 42,000 contractors. The table below reflects our 2021 consolidated EEO-1 employment data for our U.S. employees and therefore represents only 47% of our global employees and only 17% of our global workforce (which includes both employees and contractors). The data in the table does not include our approximately 13,100 employees who reside outside of the U.S, nor does this data include the approximately 42,000 contractors who comprise an integral part of our global workforce.
