



2021 SAFFORD OPERATIONS ECONOMIC IMPACT

Freeport-McMoRan's Safford operations generated **NEARLY \$314 MILLION** in economic benefits for Arizona in 2021, which includes **MORE THAN \$167 MILLION** for Graham County.
